Request for waiver of OAR 860-084 Installation Requirements

Commissioners,

Dynamic Power Innovation is submitting this request on behalf of our customer, Lake Oswego Corp Marina, which has a Portland General Electric Solar Payment Program reservation (E8X202) with an installation deadline of October 14, 2012. Dynamic Power Innovation is requesting a 30 day extension from October 14, 2012 to November 14,2012 to the OAR 860-084-2010 (1) Installation requirements in order to allow time for the system completion.

The incentive was awarded on October 14, 2011. During the original application period, all members were in agreement to apply for and install a 10.0 kWh roof mount solar array. During the following months the Marina suffered some unforeseen expenses, which caused some members of the Board to request a delay in the installation. In a July of 2012 at an annual budget meeting, the 12 member Board of Directors unanimously agreed to proceed with the installation. Even though Lake Oswego Corp Marina decided to move forward in July, they didn't formally adopt the budget supporting the project until September. As a result, Dynamic Power Innovation didn't have the official go-ahead until that time.

While the City of Lake Oswego had indicated that their plan review process could take as long as 6 weeks, we believe there's a "reasonable" chance that the installation can be completed by the current installation deadline. One potential problem is securing the required electrical and

building permits in a timely fashion. Our previous experience with permitting is that it can be permitted on the day of submission or take as long as 2 weeks.

Dynamic Power Innovation has submitted a preliminary building permit application to the City of Lake Oswego. The supporting documents, i.e. racking, structural engineering, electrical schematics and product cut sheets will be submitted today.

While we believe there's a "reasonable" chance that the installation can be completed by the current installation deadline, it appears prudent that we file for a short 30-day extension. We hope that this request shows that we are continuing to proceed in a timely and thorough manner. We will keep Commission staff apprised of our progress.

We hope that the circumstances along with the short extension request will help the commission rule in our favor. Please let me know if you need additional supporting documentation that would benefit us in a favorable decision.
