Request by Dynamic Power Innovation on behalf of our customer, Alisa Christensen for waiver of the two-month photovoltaic system interconnection application requirement set forth in OAR 800-084-0210(1).

Commissioner,

Dynamic Power Innovation is submitting this request on behalf of our Customer, Alisa Christensen, who had a Portland General Electric Solar Payment Program Reservation (25E5R3). Ms. Christensen applied for the incentive April 1st, 2014 and was put on a wait list. On June 16th, 2014 she was notified that she had received the incentive with an installation deadline of June 26th, 2015. Ms. Christensen paid the \$500.00 fee required by Portland General Electric with the intention of installing the array in the spring of 2015. Dynamic Power Innovation forwarded her the Portland General Electric Interconnection application, Portland General Electric agreement and all the necessary supporting forms. I requested she sign them and forward them to the address noted on the forms. These documents were never sent to Portland General Electric. Ms. Christensen was never notified that she had not met the two month deadline for the interconnection application and that she had been dropped from the program. Without this information, Dynamic Power Innovation proceeded with the project, acquiring all the necessary permits (permit # 5-172729-000-00RS), and parts to start the installation in June of 2015. The project was completed and an approved final inspection was performed by the City of Portland on June 16th, 2015. Dynamic Power Innovation sent the completed inspection results to Portland General Electric and was informed that Ms. Christensen had been dropped from the program.

Ms. Christensen is very excited about being a partner in PGE's solar program. She has pursued the project in good faith and did not realize that the forms had not been submitted in a timely manner.

Dynamic Power Innovation respectfully requests a waiver of rules to allow Ms. Christensen to be reinstated into the program and to forward her signed interconnection agreement now.
