RS Energy, LLC is requesting a waiver on behalf of Henry Richmond of Star Mooring Farms for his 10KW solar project. The project did not meet the two month deadline of July 8, 2015. This is due to a technical issue that arose at the site.

The issue was due to the existing service, which is a 480 delta. Historically there have been options to tie into these services at low KW ratings. However the inverter manufacture Solectria has discontinued the inverters that RS Energy had been using for these services.

Due to the lack of technical solution RS did not submit the interconnection application in the stated time frame because we did not have the required one line drawing that is part of the application.

It has taken RS Energy a couple months to figure out an economical solution to the situation, which we have found. We are no ready to put together the one line and submit the application to the utility.

RS Energy has been helping agricultural users reduce their power consumption through solar energy for the last 6 years. RS Energy has worked in multiple counties in Oregon. This project is located in Yamhill County. RS Energy has already installed two projects this year in that county. The Richmond's already have a permit issued for an additional project that RS Energy will be installing.

RS Energy has been working with two local subcontractors for 6 years. We have installed over 75 projects with them and we will be using them to install Henry's project. We are happy to be able to offer our customers quality installations and will do the same for Henry.

At this point we are ready to submit for the building and electrical permit. RS Energy has also put in soft POs for the equipment. RS Energy will be able to install the solar array once the permit is approved.

If the waiver is granted we will have the project installed by December 31, 2015.
