RULING

DISPOSITION: PETITIONS TO INTERVENE GRANTED

On September 12, 2011, petitions to intervene were filed by the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU) and Renewable Northwest Project (RNP). ICNU and RNP have sufficient interest in the proceeding, and their appearance and participation will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or unreasonably delay the proceeding. *See* OAR 860-001-0300(7). The time for objections has passed. The above petitions to intervene are granted.

On September 20, 2011, a petition to intervene was filed by the Renewable Energy Coalition (REC). REC has sufficient interest in the proceeding, and its appearance and participation will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or unreasonably delay the proceeding. *See* OAR 860-001-0300(7). REC's petition to intervene is conditionally granted, subject to filing of timely objections.
