
**Re: RE 20—Public Purpose Charge Statements of Activity—January 2022—
CORRECTION**

On February 8, 2022, PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power (PacifiCorp or the Company) filed its statements of activity for the public purpose charge collected in January 2022. The Company discovered that some of the activity included in the report was not allocated correctly between House Bill 3141 and Senate Bill 1149 and filed a corrected report on February 17, 2022 (February 17, 2022 Correction).

After filing the February 17, 2022 Correction, PacifiCorp determined that the House Bill 3141 allocation factors for each school were not aligned properly resulting in several schools receiving a check for the wrong amount. Each affected school has been contacted and the error corrected. Enclosed for filing is PacifiCorp's corrected House Bill 3141 allocation summary.
