Pacific Power would like to inform the Commission that the current installed capacity of net metering systems equals 89.2% of "one-half of one percent of the utility's, cooperative's or district's historic single hour peak load." ORS 757.300(6) allows the Commission to limit the expansion of net metering "in order to balance the interests of retail customers" when that limit has been reached.
