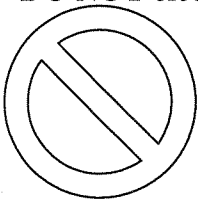

Enclosed for filing is PacifiCorp's, d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Company (Company), annual report on the unused kilowatt-hour credits and dollar amount transferred to the low-income assistance program, pursuant to OAR 860-039-0060(3) for standard net metering systems and OAR 860-084-0240(2)(c) for Oregon Solar Incentive Program systems.

As of the end of the March 2012 billing period, the Company accumulated 615,084 kilowatt-hours from standard net metering and 55,681 kilowatt-hours from the Oregon Solar Incentive Program. The Company has transferred \$19,332.41 to Oregon HEAT.
