Staff Investigation Into Qualifying Facility Contracting and Pricing.

DISPOSITION: MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME GRANTED

On July 12, 2019, PacifiCorp filed an Application for Approval of Compliance in this docket. The 30-day effective date for the submitted compliance information would be August 11, 2019, absent suspension by the Commission.

On August 9, 2019, Commission Staff filed a letter noting that: (1) Staff has yet to provide a recommendation to the Commission, and (2) Staff is expecting a supplemental filing from PacifiCorp to correct an error made by PacifiCorp in its July 12 filing. Staff requests that the effective date be suspended, according to Order No. 19-172, for an additional 30 days, thereby providing sufficient time for PacifiCorp to correct its error and to allow Staff to receive and review the anticipated corrections.

I find that Staff has shown good cause and the request to be reasonable. Staff's request is granted. Therefore, the effective date of the compliance filing is suspended 30 days. The new effective date will be September 9, 2019, pending a recommendation from Staff.
