
DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ADMIT COUNSEL *PRO HAC VICE*
GRANTED

On August 17, 2018, PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power, filed a motion to allow Jessica Buno Ralston to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. The affidavit of Ms. Buno Ralston accompanied the motion. Ms. Buno Ralston states that she will associate with Matthew McVee, an active member in good standing with the Oregon State Bar.

I have reviewed the motion for admission *pro hac vice* and find that it complies with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320. No objections have been received.

The motion to admit Jessica Buno Ralston as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of PacifiCorp is granted for a one-year period. For cases continuing over one year, an attorney appearing *pro hac vice* must file a new application to continue to participate in the case.¹
