Pursuant to ORS § 756.525 and OAR § 860-001-0300(2), the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (“ICNU”) petitions the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (“Commission”) to intervene in this proceeding with full party status as described in OAR § 860-001-0010(7). 3. ICNU is an incorporated, non-profit association of large industrial electric customers in the Pacific Northwest, with offices in Portland, Oregon. A list of ICNU members is included as Attachment A. Many of ICNU's members are customers of PacifiCorp, as shown on Attachment A.

4. On December 28, 2012, PacifiCorp filed an application with the Commission for an order allowing the Company to defer Oregon's allocated share of any incremental Open Access Transmission Tariff ("OATT") revenue associated with the Company's pending transmission rate case, Docket No. ER11-3643, at the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC") ("Application"). PacifiCorp filed this deferral because it was a condition of the partial settlement in PacifiCorp's general rate case (Docket No. UE 246). Consistent with this partial settlement, ICNU supports deferral of incremental OATT revenues, and ICNU plans to review the reasonableness and accuracy of the deferred amounts. Thus, ICNU requests leave to intervene in this Docket to represent its members who take electric service from PacifiCorp.

5. ICNU has extensive experience with proceedings involving PacifiCorp's rates. ICNU's intervention in this proceeding will assist the Commission in resolving the issues and will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or delay this proceeding.

6. As described above, ICNU has a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding that will not be adequately represented by any other party, and may be affected by any Commission determination made in connection with these proceedings. Therefore, it is in the public interest to allow ICNU to intervene in this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, ICNU respectfully requests that the Commission grant its petition to intervene with full party status in this proceeding.
