RULING

DISPOSITION: PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE LANGUAGE REVISED


On January 10, 2014, I granted a motion by Noble Americas Energy Solutions LLC (Noble) that requested modification to the procedural schedule in the above-captioned docket. I was subsequently asked by counsel for Pacific Power to revise the wording of the schedule, as adopted in the ruling, to align with the exact language set forth in the motion. This ruling makes the requested changes to the language of the proposed schedule. I note, however, that substituting the word “circulates” for the word “files” in the event that is now titled “Pacific Power circulates Proposed Tariff Language” renders the event *unofficial*. I include the event on the schedule in this ruling for the convenience of the parties, but advise that the event is not part of the Commission’s procedural schedule for this docket, and may be changed without notice to the Commission. I have also included the requested language regarding the effectiveness of the tariff, but note that this language is not normally used by the Commission and does not change the import of the event.
