DISPOSITION: SCHEDULE AMENDED


On May 13, 2013, Mr. Irion A. Sanger called to discuss a proposed revision to the schedule. Mr. Sanger also sent an email documenting our discussion. Mr. Sanger indicated that prehearing participants had discussed the opportunity for Staff and intervenors to file testimony and determined that the following revision to the schedule was appropriate: Staff and intervenors should be allowed to file, on October 18, 2013 (the same date that rebuttal testimony is due by Pacific Power), testimony that cross answers testimony filed by Staff and intervenors on September 13, 2013. Mr. Sanger represents that all parties either support or do not oppose the revision.

Treating this communication as a motion, I adopt the proposed revision. The procedural schedule is:
