RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED

By motion filed March 7, 2014, the Oregon Public Utility Commission Staff requests that schedule in these proceedings be modified. Because the next date for action is imminent, Staff asks for expedited consideration of its motion. Staff states that it has contacted all active parties to the proceeding and that no party objects to its motion.

As grounds for its motion, Staff cites a recent change to the schedule adopted in docket LC 57, the Integrated Resource Plan proceeding for PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power. Because Pacific Power and Idaho Power are co-owners of coal-fired generation facilities in Wyoming, there are some common issues between the two proceedings. Because of these commonalities, Staff wishes to synchronize the schedules in the two proceedings.

Staff filed its public meeting memorandum regarding docket LC 57 on March 4, 2014, but received an extension until March 11, 2014 to file its proposed order. Because Staff would prefer to file the proposed orders for both dockets on the same day Staff asks to extend the due date for the proposed order in this docket from March 7, 2014 to March 11, 2014.

For good cause shown, the motion is granted. Staff's proposed modified schedule is adopted.
