**Petitions to Intervene**


CUB filed its notice of intervention on July 8, 2013, in compliance with ORS 774.180.

IRP proceedings are not considered contested case proceedings under ORS 183.310(2)(a), however, obtaining party status is necessary to be placed on the service list for purposes of receiving copies of filings made by other parties and to be eligible to sign a protective order to obtain access to confidential information. For those reasons, the Commission will grant petitions to intervene in IRP dockets, even though party status does not confer the general rights and duties to individuals who participate in contested case proceedings.

Petitions to intervene were filed by ODOE, RNP, and the Renewable Energy Coalition. No party opposed these petitions and they are granted.

Parties are reminded that attorneys not licensed in Oregon wanting to appear before the Commission in this docket must file an application for admission to appear pro hac vice.<sup>1</sup>
