Dear Judge Kirkpatrick:

Pursuant to your Prehearing Conference Memorandum issued February 13, 2014, Frontier submits this status report on behalf of the Company, PUC Staff, CUB, Integra Telecom Inc., and PriorityOne Telecommunications, Inc. (collectively, the Joint Parties).

Frontier has reduced a draft stipulation and price plan, along with draft joint testimony, to writing and has circulated those documents to the Joint Parties. The Joint Parties have indicated they are in the final stages of reviewing those documents and will make suggested changes and discuss issues with the Company in due course.

Frontier anticipates that on or before April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2014, Frontier and the Joint Parties will file the agreed-upon final version of the stipulation and price plan, or will file a subsequent status report to update the ALJ.
