RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ADMIT *PRO HAC VICE* GRANTED

On August 5, 2014, Budget PrePay, Inc. filed a motion to allow Todd B. Lantor and Marc A. Paul to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. The affidavits of Messrs. Lantor and Paul accompanied the motion. The attorneys state that they will associate with Brooks E. Harlow, an active member in good standing with the Oregon State Bar.

I have reviewed the motion for admission *pro hac vice* and find that it complies with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320.

The motion to admit Todd B. Lantor and Marc A. Paul as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of Budget PrePay, Inc. is granted for a one-year period. For cases continuing over one year, an attorney appearing *pro hac vice* must file a new application to continue to participate in the case.<sup>1</sup>
