RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ADMIT *PRO HAC VICE* GRANTED

On October 6, 2014, Budget PrePay, Inc. filed a motion to allow Robert S. Koppel to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. The affidavit of Mr. Koppel accompanies the motion. Mr. Koppel states that he will associate with Brooks E. Harlow, an active member in good standing with the Oregon State Bar.

I have reviewed the motion for admission *pro hac vice* and find that it complies with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320.

The motion to admit Robert S. Koppel as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of Budget PrePay, Inc. is granted for a one-year period. For cases continuing over one year, an attorney appearing *pro hac vice* must file a new application to continue to participate in the case.¹
