
RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTIONS GRANTED; TESTIMONY AND EXHIBITS
 ADMITTED

On July 22, 2014 and September 2, 2014 respectively, Portland General Electric Company (PGE) filed motions on behalf of the stipulating parties to admit the partial and second partial stipulations and joint supporting testimony. On September 11, 2014, PGE filed a motion to admit pre-filed testimony PGE/ 200-203 and PGE/ 300-302. On September 16, 2014 the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities filed a motion to admit pre-filed testimony ICNU/100-106 and ICNU/200-201. On September 17, 2014, the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon filed a motion to admit pre-filed testimony and exhibits, CUB/100-101 (opening) and CUB/100-101 (rebuttal). On September 18, 2014, the Commission Staff filed a motion to admit testimony, Staff/101-103 and Staff/200-202. All motions were supported by witness affidavits and no party objected to the motions of the other parties.

I find that the testimony and exhibits offered by the parties meet the standards for relevance as required by OAR 860-001-0450(1) and satisfy the requirements of OAR 860-001-0480. The testimony and exhibits offered by CUB, ICNU, Staff, and PGE, both for itself and on behalf of the stipulating parties, are admitted into the record of this proceeding.
