RULING

**DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED; FILING REQUIREMENT WAIVED;
PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE SUSPENDED**

On August 18, 2014, PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power (PacifiCorp), Commission Staff, and the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon filed a stipulation resolving all issues in this docket. On the same date, the parties filed a joint motion to suspend the procedural schedule and waive OAR 860-001-0350(7)(a), which requires the filing of an explanatory brief or written testimony in support of the stipulation.

PacifiCorp's initial Power Cost Adjustment Mechanism (PCAM) filing for 2013 showed no recovery from or refund to customers, and no resulting rate change. The parties' stipulation does not alter PacifiCorp's initial calculations. Because the PCAM calculation is adequately explained by the two filings, the parties have shown good cause to waive the filing requirement in OAR 860-001-0350(7)(a). In light of the fact that the parties have reached a comprehensive settlement, the procedural schedule should be suspended.

The motion is granted. The filing requirement set forth in OAR 860-001-0350(7)(a) is waived and the procedural schedule is suspended.
