3. ICNU is an incorporated, non-profit association of large industrial electric customers in the Pacific Northwest, with offices in Portland, Oregon. A list of ICNU members is included as Attachment A. Many of ICNU's members are customers of Portland General Electric Company ("PGE"), as shown on Attachment A.

4. ICNU has a substantial interest in PGE's 2013 Annual Power Cost Variance Mechanism ("PCVM"), which was filed with the Commission on June 3, 2014. PGE states that its actual power costs were \$11.0 million greater than forecasted in rates; however, the PCVM includes a deadband under which small differences between actual and forecasted power costs are not charged or refunded to customers. ICNU requests leave to intervene in this Docket to investigate and represent its members who are affected by the operation of PGE's 2013 PCVM, which could impact the rates and quality of service that PGE provides to ICNU's members.

- 5. ICNU's intervention in this proceeding will assist the Commission in resolving the issues in this proceeding and will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or unreasonably delay this proceeding.
- 6. As described above, ICNU has a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding that will not be adequately represented by any other party, and may be affected by any Commission determination made in connection with this proceeding.
