SUBJECT: Canby Telephone Association, Advice No. 10: Revises Canby Telephone Association's Tariff PUC Or. No.3, Access Services language and rates for Intrastate Access Service in compliance with FCC regulation 47 CFR § 51.913(a)(2).

I have reviewed this filing and recommend that an acknowledgement letter be sent. The filing was submitted on September 10, 2014, and it will go into effect on October 9, 2014.

This filing revises Canby Telephone Association's Tariff PUC Or. No.3, Access Services as required by the FCC's regulations in 47 CFR § 51.913(a)(2). Effective July 1, 2014, originating Access Reciprocal Compensation for access traffic exchanged between a local exchange carrier and another telecommunications carrier in Time Division Multiplexing (TDM) format that originates and/or terminates in Internet Protocol (IP) format shall be subject to a rate equal to the relevant interstate originating access charges.
