MEMORANDUM


On April 15, 2015, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon held a procedural conference in this docket. Representatives appeared on behalf of PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power; the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon; Commission Staff; the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities; and Sierra Club.

At the conference, the Administrative Law Judge noted that all parties had waived their rights to cross-examine witnesses and to object to the acceptance of pre-filed testimony and exhibits into the record. The parties were also advised of the requirement that affidavits from sponsoring witnesses must be filed to accompany all testimony. Cross-exhibits of data responses should be accompanied by statements of counsel offering the exhibits that such exhibits are true and correct copies of the data responses.

The procedural schedule was also revised as follows:
