RULING

DISPOSITION: POWER COST SCHEDULE SUSPENDED

On July 14, 2015, Portland General Electric Company filed a motion to suspend the procedural schedule for the net variable power cost (NVPC) portion of the docket and requested expedited consideration. In support of the motion, PGE notes that only the company, Commission Staff, the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon, the Small Business Utility Advocates, and the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (Stipulating Parties) submitted testimony with respect to the NVPC portion of this docket and represents that they have participated in settlement discussions and have reached a settlement with respect to all issues but one. PGE states that the stipulating parties support the motion.

PGE represents that the stipulating parties are discussing and will soon propose a new schedule to the Administrative Law Judge to address the remaining issue on an expedited basis.

I find that good cause has been shown to suspend the schedule of the power cost portion of this docket.

The power cost schedule is suspended pending receipt of a new proposed schedule to be filed by the stipulating parties no later than July 24, 2015.
