3. I also prepared Joint Party/100 on behalf of the joint parties.

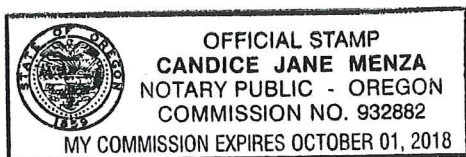
