JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RESPONSE

EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION REQUESTED

In accordance with OAR 860-001-0420(1), Idaho Power Company (Idaho Power or Company) and Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Staff) submit this motion requesting that the deadline for filing responses to Obsidian Renewables, LLC's (Obsidian) Motion to Hold Proceeding in Abeyance (Motion to Abate) be extended to November 30, 2015. Staff and Idaho Power request expedited consideration of this motion because the current due date for responses to the Motion to Abate is tomorrow, November 20, 2015. Staff intends to seek a similar extension in docket UM 1734.

As required by OAR 860-001-0420(2) and (6), Idaho Power has contacted the parties regarding this request and no party has indicated that they object. Obsidian does not object to the Motion, but Obsidian is also willing and able to adhere to the original schedule.

Obsidian filed its Motion to Abate on November 13, 2015. Due to the stage of this proceeding, on November 16, 2015, Chief Administrative Law Judge Michael Grant issued a Ruling establishing an expedited schedule for responding to the Motion to Abate. Pursuant to that expedited schedule, responses to the Motion to Abate are currently due on November 20, 2015, and Obsidian's reply is due November 25, 2015. Staff and Idaho

Granting this motion will not prejudice any party or compromise the remaining schedule in this case. The only remaining event in this docket is the simultaneous filing of post-hearing briefs, which will occur on December 10, 2015. The schedule proposed in this motion will allow parties to fully respond to the Motion to Abate prior to filing post-hearing briefs and will allow the Commission to fully consider the Motion to Abate prior to issuing a decision in this case.
