RULING


DISPOSITION: MOTIONS TO ADMIT COUNSEL *PRO HAC VICE*
GRANTED

On May 19, 2015, Gardner Capital Solar Development, LLC (Gardner Solar) filed motions to allow Kurt R. Rempe and Thomas McCann Mullooly to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in this proceeding, with supporting documents.
