RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO HOLD PROCEEDINGS IN ABEYANCE GRANTED

On November 6, 2015, Surprise Valley Electrification Corp. filed a motion requesting that portions of PacifiCorp's answer to Surprise Valley's complaint be stricken or that in the alternative, the scope of the proceedings be clarified. Within that motion, Surprise Valley also moved to hold the current procedural in abeyance pending resolution of its motion to strike/clarify. Surprise Valley states that PacifiCorp does not oppose holding the schedule in abeyance pending resolution of the motion to strike/clarification.

Surprise Valley's motion to hold the proceedings in abeyance is granted. The schedule in this matter is vacated.
