I'm writing from Neil Kelly asking you to make significant changes to the draft solar report. There was very poor public process that led to a very poor draft report. The report characterizes the solar industry as "well-supported" and "relatively robust" without defining what is meant by a "robust" industry. The report also makes recommendations to end net metering and phase out Energy Trust incentives without providing a full understanding of how solar is valued or what above-market costs might be. As a private citizen I value net metering and the Energy Trust incentives that move this industry forward. I even hope to see enhanced support of the solar industry as solar power is a critical component to a robust national security system and disaster prevention. The tone and content of their draft solar report are inaccurate and the current draft will not be helpful to the legislature.
