DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED

On July 7, 2016, Portland General Electric Company filed a motion to suspend the procedural schedule as it applies to the power cost portion of this docket. PGE requests expedited consideration of its motion. PGE states that the parties have reached an agreement in principle resolving all issues except those related to the long term gas hedging proposal.


PGE states that the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon, the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities, and the Commission Staff support the motion. Noble Americas Energy Solutions did not participate in settlement discussions and does not oppose the motion.

For good cause shown, PGE's motion is granted. The portion of the schedule as it relates to power cost issues is suspended. The schedule for hedging issues remains as set in our conference memorandum of April 18, 2016.
