- c) PGE is a public utility subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission. Decisions made and precedent established in this proceeding may directly affect PGE.

d) On May 19, 2016, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (“Commission”), in an effort to memorialize its decision made at its’ May 17, 2016, Public Meeting, ordered that a permanent rulemaking be opened, docketed as AR 600, and ordered a concurrent investigation, docketed as UM 1776, to address its competitive bidding guidelines.


