Schedule 497 was a tariff that was used to adjust natural gas rates for the recovery of capital costs associated with the Aldyl A Pipe Replacement Program, effective November 1, 2014, pursuant to Docket UG-246. The costs associated with this were incorporated into the Company's base rates in Docket No. UG-284 effective April 16, 2015.

The purpose of this housekeeping filing is to update the following items:

- First Revision Sheet B – the following tariffs were added to the Company's Table of Contents: Schedule 441 (Compressed Natural Gas Service), Schedule 469 (Public Purposes Funding Surcharge), and Schedule 475 (Decoupling Mechanism – Natural Gas). As discussed earlier, Schedule 497 (Aldyl A Pipe Replacement Program Capital Project Costs - Oregon) was removed. Finally, one text clarification relating to sheet numbering was made to Schedule 461.
