Pursuant to OAR §§ 860-001-0390(2)(b) and 860-001-0420(1), the Renewable Energy Coalition (“Coalition”) moves that Administrative Law Judge (“ALJ”) Traci Kirkpatrick grant a five-week extension of time to file reply testimony in the above captioned proceeding. The Coalition requests this extension of time due to the press of business, and to address the complexity of the case with a consultant with GRID model expertise. As testimony is currently due Friday, March 17, 2017, the Coalition requests expedited consideration of this motion.

The Coalition requests that Staff and intervenor testimony be due on April 21, 2017 (instead of March 17, 2017), response testimony be due on June 2, 2017 (instead of April 28, 2017), briefs be due on June 23, 2017 (instead of May 19, 2017), hearing tentatively and subject to Commission and ALJ availability be on June 27, 2017 (instead of May 23, 2017). The Coalition asked for the position of the active parties in this proceeding regarding an extension of time. The Commission Staff, Community Renewable Energy Association, Cypress Creek, Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities, Idaho Power Company, Northwest and Intermountain Power Producers, Oregon

Department of Energy, PacifiCorp, Portland General Electric Company, and Renewable Northwest either support or do not oppose a five week an extension of time.


