

Pursuant to OAR 860-001-0420, the Renewable Energy Coalition (“Coalition”) moves that Administrative Law Judge (“ALJ”) Traci Kirkpatrick grant a one-day extension of time to file opening briefs in the above captioned proceeding. The Coalition requests this extension of time due to the press of business. As opening briefs are currently due Friday, September 15, 2017, the Coalition requests expedited consideration of this motion.

The Coalition requests that opening briefs be due on Monday, September 18, 2017 instead of Friday, September 15, 2017.
