RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED; PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE SUSPENDED

On February 10, 2017, a prehearing conference was held in this docket at which time a procedural schedule was adopted. Among other events, the schedule provides that intervenors and Commission Staff shall file opening testimony no later than June 12, 2017.


On June 8, 2017, Portland General Electric Company (PGE) filed a motion to suspend the procedural schedule and requested expedited consideration. In support of the motion, PGE states that PGE, the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU), and Staff have reached an agreement in principal resolving all issues in this docket and that suspending the proceedings will facilitate the preparation and filing of a stipulation and joint supporting testimony. PGE states that the parties expect to submit the stipulation and joint testimony no later than June 30, 2017 or shall submit a status report with respect to their progress.

PGE further represents that the Oregon Citizens' Utility Board does not object to the proposed settlement.

RULING

For good cause shown, the motion is granted.
