**MOTION TO SUSPEND PROCEDURAL
SCHEDULE**

**EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION
REQUESTED**

For the reasons set out below, Portland General Electric Company ("PGE") hereby requests that the remaining procedural schedule in this docket be suspended.

On December 27, 2016, PGE filed its December 2016 Application for Transportation Electrification Programs with Appendices attached thereto. The purpose of that filing was to describe PGE's long-term strategy for increasing transportation electrification in our service area and to describe how the proposed programs fit within a longer-term framework. Subsequently, Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities ("ICNU"), Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon ("CUB"), Chargepoint, Inc., Drive Oregon, Oregon Department of Energy ("ODOE"), Tri-Met, Greenlots and Tesla, Inc. intervened in the docket. No other party sought intervention.

Settlement discussions between PGE, Staff of the Public Utility Commission ("Staff"), CUB, ICNU, Chargepoint, Inc., Drive Oregon, ODOE, Tri-Met, Greenlots and Tesla, Inc. (collectively the "Stipulating Parties") were held on May 12, 2017. As a result of those discussions, the Stipulating Parties have reached an agreement in principle resolving all issues in this docket but additional time is needed to finalize the details. The Stipulating Parties are in the process of completing a stipulation and supporting joint testimony and anticipate filing the

stipulation and testimony in the next few weeks.


As a result of the settlement efforts underway, PGE respectfully requests that Administrative Law Judge Harper suspend the remaining procedural schedule for briefing and testimony in this docket to give the Stipulating Parties time to finalize the details on the stipulation. At this time, PGE requests that we leave the June 1 settlement conference on the calendar in case additional discussion time is needed to finalize all of the details. PGE will notify ALJ Harper when the stipulation has been finalized. The other Stipulating Parties support this motion.

CONCLUSION AND EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION REQUEST

For the reasons discussed above, PGE requests that the Administrative Law Judge issue an order suspending the remaining procedural schedule in this docket, while preserving the June 1 settlement conference date. Pursuant to the schedule set in this docket, PGE's Rebuttal Testimony is due May 22, 2017. Accordingly, expedited consideration of this motion is requested.
