The purpose of this hearing is to allow for cross-examination of witnesses that sponsored prefiled testimony. In light of the stipulation filed in this docket, and to help further identify the scope of cross-examination, parties are asked to file a list of prefiled testimony they intend to move into the record at the hearing. Parties are asked to make this filing by 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, October 5, 2017.

To allow additional time for the hearing, the start time is moved to 1:00 p.m. During the hearing, I may, on my own motion, disallow any repetitive questioning. The order of questioning of witnesses is set forth below.

Portland General Electric Company witnesses Aaron Milano and Jacob Goodspeed, who filed joint written testimony, will be cross-examined as a panel.



All other witnesses not identified for cross-examination are excused from the hearing. If the Commission has questions for a witness not appearing, a bench request will be issued after the hearing.
