PREHEARING CONFERENCE
MEMORANDUM AND RULING

On July 24, 2017, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon held a prehearing conference in this docket. Representatives appeared on behalf of Portland General Electric Company (PGE); the Oregon Citizens' Utility Board (CUB); ChargePoint, Inc.; Electric Vehicle Charging Association (EVCA); Greenlots; Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU); and Commission Staff.

Procedural Schedule

The parties agreed to the following procedural schedule, which is adopted:
