RE: UE 319 July MONET Update

Enclosed is PGE's July 10, 2017, MONET update for Docket No. UE 319. This update includes contracts and electric and gas forward curves as of June 1, 2017. PGE's Net Variable Power Cost (NVPC) forecast for 2018 totals approximately \$346.3 million, a decrease of roughly \$6.3 million from the March 31, 2017 power cost update filing. This decrease is primarily due to the NVPC impact of terms resulting from a draft stipulation reached between PGE, Staff of the Public Utility Commission, the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon, the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities, and Fred Meyer Stores, Inc.
