MEMORANDUM AND NOTICE


**DISPOSITION: NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF NON-CONTESTED CASE PROCEDURES**

In Order No. 17-152, the Commission opened an investigation into utility participation in the Oregon Clean Fuels Programs. On May 4, 2017, Commission Staff filed a Motion to Pursue Non-Contested Case Process and on May 5, 2017, the Chief Administrative Law Judge granted Staff's motion and adopted a proposed procedural schedule.

In light of the designation of this docket as a non-contested case proceeding, persons are hereby notified that the Administrative Hearings Division (AHD) will not at this time entertain petitions to intervene as parties. We note that a Notice of Intervention by the Oregon Citizens' Utility Board was filed on May 5, 2017 and Petitions to Intervene were subsequently filed by PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power; the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities; Portland General Electric Company; and Idaho Power Company.

Moreover, AHD has learned that Staff is currently preparing a revised schedule to address stakeholder conflicts with dates set forth in the May 5, 2017 Ruling. Accordingly, all inquiries regarding scheduling in this docket should be addressed to the Commission Staff.
