RULING

DISPOSITION: PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AMENDED

DISCUSSION


The proposed schedule is contingent upon consideration by the Commission of an as-yet unfiled request for certification of the ruling denying complainants' motion to strike certain PGE testimony issued by the administrative law judge (ALJ) on March 22, 2018.

All events and associated dates subsequent to the filing of PGE's response to the request for certification are contingent upon both the certification of the ruling to the Commission and the Commission affirming the ALJ's ruling within the "aspirational target for Commission decision on certification." The parties acknowledge that the failure of either of the contingent events to occur will necessitate the adoption of a revised schedule.

RULING

The schedule is adopted subject to the contingencies noted above.
