SUSPENDED


On September 11, 2017, Portland General Electric Company (PGE) filed an unopposed motion to suspend the procedural schedule. PGE requests expedited consideration because, under the current schedule, Staff and intervenors' testimony is due today, September 11, 2017.

In support of its motion, PGE states that Staff of the Public Utility Commission and the Oregon Citizens' Utility Board support this motion. PGE states that the parties have reached settlement of all issues and are preparing a stipulation and joint explanatory brief.

For good cause shown, PGE's motion is granted. The procedural schedule is suspended.

PGE is directed to file the final stipulation and supporting testimony no later than November 1, 2017.
