PREHEARING CONFERENCE  
REPORT AND RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO STRIKE GRANTED; SCHEDULE REVISED

On March 19, 2018, Portland General Electric Company (PGE) filed a motion to strike and a motion to suspend its reply to complainants' response to PGE's motion for summary judgment.

On March 20, 2018, a telephone prehearing conference was held at which time the parties discussed the pending PGE motions. Based upon statements of the parties during these discussions, the administrative law judge (ALJ) granted the PGE motion to strike upon representation of PGE counsel that it would not seek to deprive the complainants of the opportunity to file a motion or motions for summary judgment upon procedural grounds. The procedural schedule was also further revised.

**RULINGS**

1. The motion to strike and a motion to suspend its reply to complainants' response to PGE's motion for summary judgment is granted to the extent indicated. The following language is stricken from the record of the complainants' March 9, 2018 response:
  - a. Page 1: "and instead grant summary judgment to the Complainants."

ISSUED: March 20, 2018

- b. Page 10: “and the Commission should instead grant summary judgment to the Complainants.”
- 2. The schedule with respect to addressing motions for summary judgement is to be as follows:

PGE Reply to Complainants' Response to Motion for Summary Judgment	April 6, 2018
First Date on which Complainants may file Motion for Summary Judgment	April 6, 2018
Complainants' Sur-Response to PGE Reply Motion for Summary Judgment	April 20, 2018
