RULING

DISPOSITION: PETITIONS TO INTERVENE GRANTED FOR
 LIMITED PURPOSES

The Commission has received petitions to intervene in this docket from Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU), Northwest and Intermountain Power Producers Coalition (NIPPC), National Grid USA (National Grid), Renewable Northwest, and NW Energy Coalition (NWECC).

This proceeding is not a contested case proceeding under ORS 183.310(2). Nonetheless, obtaining party status is necessary for purposes of receiving copies of filings made by others and to be eligible to sign a protective order to obtain access to confidential information. For those reasons, the Commission will grant the petitions to intervene, even though party status does not confer the general rights and duties to individuals who participate in contested case proceedings.

The petitions to intervene filed by ICNU, NIPPC, National Grid, Renewable NW, and NWECC are granted for the limited purposes described above.
