I. INTRODUCTION

Douglas Services, Inc., d/b/a Douglas Fast Net ("DFN"), respectfully submits this application to expand its designated service area as a federal and state Eligible Telecommunications Carrier ("ETC") and an Eligible Telecommunications Provider ("ETP") to receive Oregon Universal Service Fund ("OUSF") support and provide, Lifeline and OTAP services in the Culp Creek, Cottage Grove, Lowell, Veneta, Creswell, Lakeside, Azalea, Myrtle Creek, Riddle, Canyonville and Days Creek wire centers. DFN also requests ETC/ETP status to provide Lifeline services to the Empire, Eugene 10th, Junction City, River Road and Springfield wire centers. The requested expansion of the ETC/ETP designated service area is for all purposes including participating in the federal Lifeline program and the Oregon Telephone Assistance Program ("OTAP"), and for receiving federal and state support as identified above.

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II. BACKGROUND

The Commission first designated DFN as a federal ETC and ETP in 2015 in Docket No. UM 1721.¹ That designation was largely for the purpose of receiving federal high-cost support under the Rural Broadband Experiment ("RBE"). All ETCs receiving high-cost support must also offer Lifeline services by federal rule and the corresponding OTAP services by state requirements. DFN's designated service area for RBE funds consisted of multiple census blocks for which the FCC granted DFN Rural Broadband Experiment funding.

On February 2, 2018, in Docket No. UM 1896, Order No. 18-040, the Commission designated DFN as a state ETC to receive Oregon Universal Service Fund ("OUSF") support in six wire centers: Camas Valley, Drain, Glide, Yoncalla, Sutherlin and Winston. ² In that same order, the Commission also designated DFN as a federal ETC, but only for the limited purpose of offering federal Lifeline services, and as an ETP for the purpose of participating in the OTAP in those same six wire centers. The federal designation was limited to Lifeline-only because no federal high-cost support funds were available in those areas at that time. Even though the Roseburg wire center is surrounded by several of the wire centers for which OUSF support was requested, it was not included in the request for state or federal ETC designation because no OUSF funds were available for that area.

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SUPPLEMENTAL APPLICATION - 3

On October 23, 2018, also in Docket Um 1896, but by Order No. 18-417, the Commission expanded DFN's designation for the entire Roseburg wire center for the purpose of offering Lifeline and OTAP services.³

On February 4, 2019, the Commission granted the Application of DFN for designation as an ETC and ETP for certain census blocks which were awarded through the FCC's Connect America Fund Phase II ("CAF II") Auction, also known as Auction 903.4

Recently DFN sought designation as a state ETC and ETP for various wire centers as a result of its acquisition of the assets of Comspan. The Commission granted the application.⁵

DFN now seeks to expand the designated service area previously granted to it so that it can offer Lifeline/OTAP services and receive federal and state support throughout the Culp Creek, Cottage Grove, Lowell, Veneta, Creswell, Lakeside, Azalea, Myrtle Creek, Riddle, Canyonville and Days Creek wire centers to the extent not already so designated. In addition, DFN seeks ETC/ETP status to provide Lifeline services in the Empire, Eugene 10th, Junction City, River Road and Springfield wire centers.

DFN MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS FOR ETC AND ETP DESIGNATION III.

DFN meets all of the applicable Commission requirements for federal ETC designation specified in Order No. 15-382⁶ as evidenced by the previous filings submitted and approved in Order No. 15-159, Order No. 18-040, Order No. 18-417, Order 19-040 and Order 20-395.

DFN will offer Lifeline/OTAP discounts to qualifying residents in the same manner as it does in areas where it is already designated. DFN commits to offer and advertise Lifeline and OTAP services throughout all of the wire centers for which it receives designation. DFN will offer Lifeline/OTAP discounts as set out in federal and state rules.

DFN is currently participating in the OTAP and confirms its commitment to follow all applicable OTAP and RSPF requirements.

DFN commits to comply with all applicable federal and Oregon regulations and reporting requirements for ETC and ETP designation.

IV. GRANTING THE REQUEST IS IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST

Granting DFN's request to expand its designated service area is in the public interest. Designating DFN as an ETC/ETP will not put an undue burden on either the federal or the state fund.

A map showing the designated service area is attached as Exhibit A.

V. CONCLUSION

For the reasons explained above, DFN respectfully requests that the Commission grant its application to expand its designation as a federal and state ETC and ETP for the purposes set out herein.
