REQUEST FOR EXPEDITED
CONSIDERATION; PARTIES' MOTION
TO AMEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

9 Pursuant to OAR 860-001-0420, Hydro One Limited and Avista ("Applicants"); the Staff
10 of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon ("Staff"); the Oregon Citizens' Utility Board
11 ("CUB"); the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers ("AWEC")¹; and the Laborers'
12 International Union of North America with its affiliated District Council and Local Unions
13 ("LIUNA")² (hereinafter "Parties") respectfully request, on an expedited basis, that Judge Power
14 modify the procedural schedule established by Judge Power's May 14, 2018 Ruling in this
15 docket. The Parties to this docket previously filed an all-party Stipulation resolving all issues in
16 this proceeding, and were to file testimony in support of this Stipulation by June 13, 2018.³ The
17 Parties request an extension of the June 13, 2018, filing date to June 19, 2018, in order to allow
18 for additional time to assure that the supporting testimony is comprehensive in nature. Because
19 Judge Power recently vacated the June 21, 2018 date for oral argument, the Parties do not believe
20 that an extension of the filing date for supporting testimony will prejudice the remaining
21 schedule.

22 Pursuant to OAR 860-001-0420(2), Hydro One and Avista have conferred with the
23 Parties to this docket and all Parties support this request, made on the behalf of all Parties,


