RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ADMIT COUNSEL *PRO HAC VICE*
GRANTED

On September 18, 2018, Hydro One Limited filed motions to renew the admissions of Kari Vander Stoep and Elizabeth Thomas as counsel *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. The affidavits of Kari Vander Stoep and Elizabeth Thomas accompanied the motions. In their affidavits, Vander Stoep and Thomas state that each will associate with Teresa A. Hill, an active member in good standing with the Oregon State Bar.

Vander Stoep and Thomas were each admitted as counsel *pro hac vice* On October 6, 2017. For cases continuing over one year, an attorney appearing *pro hac vice* must file a new application to continue to participate in the case.¹

I have reviewed the motions for admission *pro hac vice* and find that each motion complies with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320. No objections have been received.

The motions to admit Kari Vander Stoep and Elizabeth Thomas as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of Hydro One Limited are granted for an additional one-year period.
