RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ADMIT COUNSEL *PRO HAC VICE*
GRANTED

On September 18, 2018, Hydro One Limited filed a motion to allow Benjamin A. Mayer to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. The affidavit of Benjamin A. Mayer accompanied the motion. Mayer states that he will associate with Teresa A. Hill, an active member in good standing with the Oregon State Bar.

I have reviewed the motion for admission *pro hac vice* and find that it complies with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320. No objections have been received.

The motion to admit Benjamin A. Mayer as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of Hydro One Limited is granted for a one-year period. For cases continuing over one year, an attorney appearing *pro hac vice* must file a new application to continue to participate in the case.¹
