Re: PCN-2 – Tillamook People’s Utility District’s Land Use Status Update

Dear Judge Moser and Judge Allwein:

During the prehearing conference held in this docket on April 4, 2018, Administrative Law Judge Patrick Power requested that Petitioner Tillamook People’s Utility District (Tillamook PUD) provide an update on the status of Tillamook County’s land use proceedings relating to the Oceanside Transmission Line. Tillamook PUD has understood this to be a standing request and has filed updates in this docket from time to time as the various land use phases have concluded.

The purpose of this letter is to advise the currently assigned administrative law judges and the parties of the conclusion of the most recent phase of the County’s land use proceedings. On June 19, 2019, the Oregon Court of Appeals issued notice of a decision affirming the decision of the Land Use Board of Appeals (“LUBA”), which in turn upheld the County’s approval of each of the land use permits Tillamook PUD requested for the Oceanside Transmission Line that is the subject of this proceeding. The Court affirmed LUBA’s decision without an opinion, but notice of the decision can be viewed on the Court’s website by viewing “Advance Sheets 2019 # 14” and searching for the docket “A170642” at the following website:
