3. If the petitioner is an organization, the number of members in and the purposes of the organization:

Oregon Dairy Farmers Association (ODFA) represents the 228 multi-generational Grade A dairy farms in Oregon. ODFA strives to create an atmosphere that is conducive for all Oregon dairy producers.

4. The nature and extent of the Petitioner's interest in the proceeding is:

ODFA has a direct interest in these proceedings as we have 90 producers in Tillamook County, several of whom will be directly impacted by Tillamook People's Utility District's authorization of the construction of an 8.6 mile overhead transmission line through valuable agricultureal land in Tillamook County. The construction of the transmission line would have substantial impacts to current farming practices including nutrient application.

5. The issues the Petitioner intends to raise at the proceeding are:

ODFA intends to address whether the proposed transmission line is necessary and whether it can or should receive land use approval at the local level, as outlined in our joint comments with Oregon Farm Bureau dated November 14, 2017. The loss of the ability to farm and use current farming practices along with the division of farm land is also very concerning.

6. The special knowledge or expertise of the Petitioner that would assist the Commission in resolving the issues in the proceeding is:

ODFA has represented the Oregon dairy industry since 1892. Tami Kerr, Executive Director of ODFA, and Chad Allen, ODFA Board President and Tillamook dairy farmer, have extensive knowledge and expertise in public policy and land use issues.
