SUB completed our first cycle of 10-year detailed overhead NESC inspections in 2009 and corrections in 2011. This was communicated through our 5-year check-in submission in 2012. In 2012 SUB began the 2nd 10-year detailed overhead NESC inspection cycle after upgrading our hardware and software systems for conducting these inspections.

SUB has facilities on 9,010 poles including foreign owned. From 2012 through 2017 SUB has inspected 5,458 or ~60.5% of these poles.
